ii) **Dog Fouling** - Complaint from resident. Clerk has contacted NWBC to re-apply stencils on pavements. iii) **Village Clock** - £3000 repairs are required. The clock weight wire has broken and the weight has fallen whilst being wound. The weight is caught part way down the tower. GH has reported this and Smiths have been out to inspect. The weight is 185kg and is balanced on a damaged beam. Weight has been tied off with a rope. Smiths to come out urgently this week to repair. DW to organise a petition for support of the clock repair to aid grant application to Mercia Fund. DC help with collecting letters of support.
