

Allington Hill and Coopers Wood & Field Community Group Environmental Statement

The Allington Hill and Coopers Wood & Field Community Group is a volunteer group working with the Woodland Trust to maintain and enhance Allington Hill and with Allington Parish Council to maintain and enhance Coopers Wood & Field. Children, young people and vulnerable adults are encouraged to join in the general activities and in the events held during the year.

The group has a constitution governing its activities.

There is a Committee consisting of between 3 and 15 volunteers. This committee organises work days, events and fund raising.

There is no formal membership of the Allington Hill and Coopers Wood & Field Community Group.

Specific events are held 2 / 3 times a year, with activities provided for children. These events are open to anyone who wishes to attend,

There is an outdoor play trail consisting of sturdy play equipment suitable for children and adults. Use of this equipment is not supervised by the Allington Hill Volunteers.

Environment Statement.

The primary aim of the group is to: -
