No further update from NCC.
- 2) Drain by 18 Oxendon Road blocked photos sent No immediate safety defects or flooding at time of visit will continue to monitor through highway safety inspections. Drainage issue has been logged and will be undertaken as part of our routine cleansing programme to be undertaken by the end of March 2020. Clerk to report again as this was not done before the end of March. No further update from NCC.
- 3) The beech hedge by the burial ground. To be undertaken in September after the nesting season. COMPLETE
- 4) Drain on Kelmarsh Road very wet even though the weather has been dry. LS to send photograph. Clerk to report. No further update from NCC
- 5) Drains outside 3/4 and 4/5 Hall Close completely blocked (reported before meeting) Reported again as only 1 drain was cleared..COMPLETE

Note - Where possible, photos to be taken of highway problems to be used in the reporting system.

Following the letter written after the last meeting asking for clarification of the outstanding maintenance issues NCC replied:-

Currently according to our gulley emptying programme / records the gullies in Arthingworth were cleansed on the 3rd of January 2020.

Specifically 18 Oxendon lane looks to have been cleaned and was operational on leaving, there was one outside the pub which is listed as vehicle over that was not done, The water issue on Kelmarsh road is a long standing one that I seem to remember has been investigated and we think it is a spring.

There are so many limiting factors to producing the gulley programme that we can only give a rough window as to when we will be visiting and currently it looks like the next visit will be in January next year dependent on weather and funding. Whilst we would dearly love to give a date it is just not possible. Our crews will usually try to get cars moved but this is not always possible.

I will look at the gullies you mention but if they are not actually causing flooding issues it is unlikely that we will be able to arrange a special visit. If there are problems with specific areas and flooding issues then we will review this.
