

Weston Broadband

We have been in contact with Open Reach to install Fibre to the Premises (FTTP) and have been quoted a ballpark figure of £174,326, which would supply high speed fibre broadband to 146 properties in Weston. At the moment there is a voucher scheme provided by the government and NCC, which would mean that there is no initial cost to households to have this installed. The only requirement would be for households to sign up to get a broadband speed which doubles their current one.
