Remedi- outcome of the meeting held on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup>- Youth offender community service

The Clerk and Mr T Cooper met with Mr Tony Jackson, Remedi manager from the Nottinghamshire County Council. A service level agreement has been drawn up for the young offenders to clear the Church yard, keep the grass mown and general maintenance of borders and to clear litter at Cromwell Halt and the lay by. The work will most likely commence in late August.

The Parish Council formally agreed to sign the agreement and take this issue on board. Proposed by Mr T Cooper, seconded by Mr C Hemstock, all in agreement. The Clerk will write to the Church PCC. The Clerk to also write to Cromwell Parish Meeting to inform them and seek approval for clearing the area around Cromwell Halt.
