Discussion	<p>The traffic survey with KCC was completed and results had been received.</p> <p>The data received was not as expected and showed traffic levels lower than data from 2014 and 2018 which was considered unlikely and no</p> <p>There were several areas of concern which may have skewed the date: The closure of Aylesham Rd due to the recent murder investigation. The closure of Mill Lane. The delay in positioning the strips outside Prima.</p> <p>The Chairman was hoping to meet with KCC and discuss the results.</p> <p>KCC had produced a plan for traffic coming into the village along Sandwich Rd at a cost of £5.8k. This plan involved new road markings. Cllr Manion would be asked if he could fund some or all of this project.</p> <p>Cllr Clayton offered to site the dashcam on the village hall.</p> <p>Footpath EE316 was overgrown and the Clerk would write a letter of complaint to Sollys.</p> <p>A parishioner mentioned the amount of dog excrement being left by irresponsible dog owners. Cllr Perrin would put up more notices particularly at the bottom of the footpath know as Leafy Lane.</p> <p>KCC has asked for comments on local bus services. All interested residents are encouraged to follow the link on the PC website to the KCC page where comments can be made. The details are also on a poster on the noticeboard.</p>
