## Leamington National Finals

The Bowls England National Finals took place last month with our players involved in five events.

**Kat Bowman** and Whitwick's Beth Ward were runners up in the women's junior pairs, losing out to Worcestershire's Izzie White and Maddie Burgess in the final. **Kat** was also in the junior singles, she lost to Hannah Maslen (Sussex) who went on to reach the semi final.

Leicestershire's Amy Rose team, including **Kat** and **Deam Walker** were beaten by a strong Kent in the semi final with Kent going on to win the title.

**Pa Walker** reached the quarter final of the women's singles before losing to Suffolk's Sal Butcher, and **Pa** and **Shane Hayes** were quarter finalists in the mixed pairs, beaten by Kent's Leah Bamford and Michael Fisher.



In their first season of entering the competition, our women's Top Club team just missed out on a place at Leamington as they were beaten 2.5-1.5 by Wigton (Cumbria) at Thirsk in the last 16.
