12. Is there anything about the current facilities that deter you from visiting the Playing Fields?




Comments:

- h. Closure of playground facilities, relatively poor surface of the tennis court.




29. BASKETBALL HOOP OR NETBALL GOAL









30. If more benches were to be provided around the playground area, for adults supervising children, which would you use the most?



34. Do you think there should be an outdoor water fountain available for players to use?








- Cricket pitch and nets

- Leave it as is. It's a fantastic outdoor recreation space but also a lovely field for a variety of activities. Please don't introduce too much infrastructure or apparatus and spoil it's open feel and adaptable use.
- How about some adult gym/keep fit equipment? South Wonston playing field have some wonderful exercise equipment which doesn't take up a lot of room and would encourage all ages to have a go at getting fitter.
- Proper fence and signs saying no dogs in play area
- An improved Playground would be a fantastic addition to the village.
- Maybe more community based seating so we can host village events in the field, this would ensure a better safety for everyone.
- Reinstate the cricket pitch
- cut grass more often to avoid clods of cut and rotting grass on surface, Preferably cut with gang mower or fine chop
- The playground needs a variety of apparatus to suit all age groups especially the toddler age group
- Picnic benches would be really good to have
- A coffee shop/cafe would be good

- Wild flowers


