# Create new vehicular access, parking and turning facilities (demolish part of existing boundary wall)

Members had taken written and verbal representation on this application. The Parish Council had also requested further information from the applicant.

Concerns were raised as to the removal of the flint wall, as it was within the conservation area, flooding in the area due to the removal of natural barriers and pedestrian safety.

### **OBJECTION**

The Parish Council objected on the following grounds:

- 1. Access. No plan had been submitted, despite additional requests, to show how a vehicle could safety navigate to the site. This raised serious concerns to pedestrian safety on a very well used lane.
- 2. Removal of flint wall. The application is in a conservation area. It was noted that the parking area (if approved) would remove a vehicle from the road.
- 3. Environmental impact. The Parish Council already raised concerns that the Environment Agency were not a consultee on this application. Although a permeable surface was to be established, it was felt this would not replace the natural soakage in an area known for surface flooding. It was also felt that works were too close to river bank of the Bere stream which, in time, may could excessive erosion and collapse of the river bank.
