Automated External Defibrillator



As a joint decision between the Parish Council and the Village Hall Committee, We have purchased and installed an External Defibrillator at the village hall. It is there for anyone to use should the need arise to save life (Though we hope this never happens).

It is in a secure cabinet which requires a 4 digit code to be entered on the keypad followed by the tick key.

The code will be given by the emergency operator when you **<u>Dial 999</u>** stating that you need the defibrillator from the <u>Lydden Village Hall, 83 Canterbury Road CT15 7EX.</u> When you open th front acces panel on th defibrillator you will recieve verbal instructions on how to use the device so you do not need to be trained in its use to use it.

Please replace the device in the cabinet after use and inform a member of the Parish Council. This is so that it can be checked and the pads replaced for further use.

Once again We hope that it will never be needed but it is there for peace of mind and can be used to save life.
