The council have supplied us with replacement bench planks, would any of our members like to volunteer to apply oil to these before fixing them into position then help to remove the old planks and install the new ones.

Kevin has been busy by up-cycling three of old bench tables to make two tables, which are place on either side of the green. He has also built another picnic table.

Jeff Borg Catering has been retained for catering needs this year, there are two events where due to prior bookings he is unable to provide the catering, for these two we have asked Paul to provide the catering.

If any of our green fingered members would like to take on supplying or replenishing the existing hanging baskets. As in the past it would be apricated.
