

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PART OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH 38, CHIDEOCK

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 14 [1] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended. **All pedestrians, horse riders and cyclists will be prohibited from proceeding along FOOTPATH 38, from grid reference SY 414 933 (point A on the map below) to grid reference SY 417 933 (point B on the map below) a distance of approximately 400 metres.** The Order is needed in order to comply with health and safety regulations, which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to highway users.

It will come into operation on 23 August 2023 for a period of 26 weeks but it will remain in force for 26 weeks and can be extended with the approval of the Secretary of State for Transport, if necessary.

This Order is required to allow Ringway to undertake construction works on the A35 and area to the East of the carriageway.

On this occasion there is no alternative route.
