

# Traditional Materials & Designs

## Weatherboarding

Traditionally white on domestic buildings and black on farm buildings (also when converted). Either full façade or on upper elevations only.



## Peg Tiles & Bricks

Mainly multi-hued, ranging from bluish-red to reddish-brown. Tiles generally darker than bricks. Hung on part or full facade. Historically made from local clay



# Special Features & Details

## Roof Profiles

Houses of all ages (and old farm buildings) typically have hipped or half-hipped roofs.

Clay tiles are the norm


