	<p>Cliffe <> Cliffe Woods <> London (Commuter service, morning out, evening in) Higham Railway Station, Strood/Rochester/Chatham Sunday – 193 (Medway subsidised service) does not go directly from/to Cliffe but diverts via Hoo. First bus leaves Cliffe at 9.30 but does not stop to pick people up on its way to Cliffe from Strood (e.g. Cliffe Woods). The first church service starts at 9.30. (The first passenger bus into Cliffe arrives at 11.30 which is too late for both church services). The Buttway is always full of cars on Sunday mornings so there is obviously a need for an earlier passenger carrying bus service. Medway council are paying for a public service on Sundays that the public cannot use to get to St Helens church services on Sundays.</p>
