Whether it is the establishment of Whatsapp groups, the offer of assistance with shopping, or just the occasional friendly enquiry as to our wellbeing, the support throughout the village has been extraordinary, and much appreciated. I can only imagine how those who are isolated and alone must find the current situation, but how much worse it would be without the love and support of those around them.

BE KIND TO ONE ANOTHER I can only imagine that one villager was having a bad day recently when she chose to criticise another villager (who lives alone and in isolation) for employing a local handy man to paint her garden fence.

- 1. There is no regulation requiring self employed people not to work they too have families to feed, and the government will not be paying them anything until June, unless they claim Universal Credit.
- 2. The tradesman was local, and only travelled a couple of miles to and from the job.
- 3. The work was outside, but within the bounds of a private garden, and the tradesman was observing the 2 metre rule at all times.

As a result of this ill-informed and unsolicited criticism, the villager was very much upset, as they had no conception that their actions could be so badly misinterpreted. The tradesman was denied his right to earn a living while operating within the guidelines from the Government. Furthermore another tradesman, who had been contracted to paint the outside of the villager's house, was also denied the opportunity to earn a legitimate living.

Incidentally, the Village Hall Management committee have contracted the aforementioned painter/decorator to paint the inside of the Village Hall while it is out of use. He will, of course, be alone in the hall at all times, and will observe the 2 metre rule if approached.
