- a) Councillors asked that the following response be sent to the TWBC Enforcement Officer regarding application no. 18/02849, The Anchorage, Langton Road, Speldhurst: We note that the acoustic fence is no longer permitted development as the hedge has been removed. The Parish Council strongly objects to the removal of the hedge which should be replaced immediately with tall hedging plants or the fence should be taken down.
- b) It was noted that the field behind Bradleys Mill in Speldhurst which had been put on the brownfield site register had now been reclassified as greenfield.

Proposal: Change of use from B1 to D1. The premises are currently vacant. It is proposed to use the premises as an adult education centre to teach pottery classes for KCC Community Learning Skills (Adult Education). Temporary change of use is required for a 3-year period.

Decision: Object unless adequate on-site parking can be ensured for students and staff during the daytime sessions as well as the evening, as any overflow would contribute to existing parking and congestion problems on this busy stretch of road.

Proposal: Trees: Common lime (T25) – Reduce faulted/limb stems by 30%; Wild Cherry (T29) – Fell; Common Hornbeam (T27) – Raise low canopy to 3M; Common lime (T15) – Raise low canopy to 2.5M; Common Lime (T0) – Raise low canopy to

2.5M; Common Lime (T8) – Raise low canopy to 3M.

Decision: Support.

Proposal: Trees: Oak Tree – prune to the previous pruning points.

Decision: Remain neutral, leave to Tree Officer.

Location: Shandon, Monteith Close, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells, Kent TN3 0AD Proposal: Trees: Oak (T1) – reduce by 30% and reduce large bow over garden by around 60% to match the remaining canopy. Oak (T2 part G3 TPO) reduce by 30% and raise canopy. Oak (T3 park

G3 TPO) – reduce by 30% and raise canopy.

Proposal: Single storey rear extension and fence re-alignment to the northern boundary.

Decision: We object on the grounds of insufficient information. The application does not include floor plans or show the fence realignment. We request that the extent of the applicant's land ownership be verified with the Land Registry.

Location: 57 The Boundary, Langton Green, Royal Tunbridge Wells, Kent TN3 0YA

Proposal: Demolition of conservatory and erection of single storey rear extension, plus part garage conversion with creation of first floor.

Decision: We object on the basis that the description does not accurately reflect the proposed extension and the changes to the garage footprint. We would ask that the application is resubmitted with an accurate description of the changes.

9. Items for information

- a) Cllr Round said that he believed the work carried out on 36 Newlands, Langton Green did not comply with the planning permission given by TWBC for the new side extension to be part-clad, part-rendered. The whole of the front of the extension had been clad, together with an approximate 1 metre strip of cladding on the side, adjoining the front corner of the extension. The Assistant Clerk was asked to email TWBC's Enforcement Officer regarding this matter.
- b) Cllr Round voiced concern regarding a large oak tree at Speeds Farm in Langton Green which had been felled, in his opinion, unnecessarily. The Assistant Clerk advised that this matter had been investigated and as the tree was not protected, unfortunately no action could be taken.
- c) Cllr Round raised a query regarding application no. 18/03482. It was agreed that this matter would be investigated by Councillors and discussed at the next Planning Committee meeting.
