There is still a great deal of technical work to be done and residents are being asked for their input at an early stage.

The Lorry Watch scheme was discussed and it was noted that residents can report offending lorries on the KCC website and the companies will be followed up. It was confirmed that the bus service consultation will be reviewed following Cllr Paul Carter's intervention.

Cllr Hohler reported that there is some funding left in the members grant for any Birling projects.

(a) KALC Tonbridge & Malling Meeting

Cllr Westwood reported that items discussed included the bus consultation, the snowploughing plan, training waiting lists and changes in the community safety unit. Kent Mineral and Waste consultation was also discussed. Public Space Protection Orders and Dog Control Orders were noted as being an issue for the borough council. J5 slips and wider traffic issues were discussed and it was noted that MP Mr Tom Tugenhadt has encouraged parish councils to support UK highways improvements consultation in order to access the national funding. Further investigations are required to reference the specific consultation. It was **AGREED** to respond to the consultation when the matter was clarified.
