**For Action:**

The Cotswold School:

The School has forwarded an invoice for the deposit paid of £7,049.35 for its steel framed tennis court cover and has asked that the Council releases the grant of £5,000 awarded last October.

Encore PR:

Invitation for Council to participate in the Kingfisher Trail, Cotswolds 2021, from May to September which is being launched by Cotswolds National Landscape to connect visitors and residents within the local area. Request for Council to be a host on the Thames Trail by purchasing a medium sized kingfisher model for £800 or a large model for £1200 (full details circulated).

Bourton Litter Picking Group:

Report received from group co-ordinator, Sue Roberts, summarising first month's achievements and findings. Request for Council to consider proposal for installation of signage to help tackle the problem (circulated).

Correspondence:
