WORLDHAM PARISH PLAN UPDATE

The Parish Council has recognised the need to update the Parish Plan published in 2010 to help guide the future of East Worldham, West Worldham and Hartley Mauditt. The original Parish Plan is available to download from the parish website, www.worldham.org.

A sub-committee of the Parish Council has been set up to carry out the review. One of the first actions of this committee is to carry out a preliminary survey to obtain views on the topics parishioners would like to be considered for a more detailed questionnaire. This questionnaire will help update our Parish Plan for the future so your views are extremely important.

Arising from some of the action points listed in our Parish Plan the following are examples of what has been achieved in the last seven years:

refurbishment of the playground
modernisation of the kitchen in the village hall
re-roofing of Hartley Mauditt Church
development of Worldham website
30 mph speed limit on B3004 at E Worldham

repairs to East Worldham Church tower
pedestrian refuge outside the village hall
Neighbourhood Watch revised and renewed
