

### Q6 Is this your main address in the UK?











## Q11 Which of the following categories best describes your employment status?





### Q12 If you are in work, how do you usually travel to your place of work?





### Q13 If you are a student or in work, where is your main workplace?









### Q17 How often do you currently use the village hall?




