Surrenden Playing Field – The Lease from Maidstone Borough was renewed for a term of 125-years and expires on 21st April 2144.

Youth Club Land - The Lease from Kent County Council for the Youth Club Land includes an Option to Purchase at any time within the term of the Lease. Each year £850 is paid to Kent County Council of which £250 represents rent and £600 represents capital towards the purchase of the land in 2050 at the agreed purchase price of £30,000 plus adjustment for RPI. As at 31^{st} March 2021 a total of £12,600 towards the purchase price had been paid.

Parish Office Lease – Agreement had been reached for a new lease for the rental of Rooms 1, 2, 3 and 8 at Staplehurst Village Centre for a term of 3 years from 1^{st} November 2007 at a combined annual rent of £4,200. In early 2014 an additional room was agreed to be rented for Staplehurst Society historical work at an additional £150 per annum. Completion of the legal paperwork at 31.03.2021 remained outstanding so the existing terms of the lease run on.

EARMARKED RESERVES & ONGOING PROJECT BUDGETS

- General Fund Parish Councils are unable to borrow money without Government approval, which
 can be time-consuming to obtain. The sum of £20,031.35 was added to the General Fund making
 a new total of £65,506.93 to be held for any unbudgeted or unforeseen emergencies that may
 require funds to be urgently applied. This has facilitated in keeping the precept at the same level
 as 2020-2021.
- <u>Parish Projects</u> The Council has set aside funding towards six projects in the parish: the reestablishment of allotment provision; a fund for outside works; maintenance of the Wimpey Field
 land gifted by Taylor Wimpey; works at Surrenden Playing Field to upgrade the paths; grant funding
 received towards the cost of enhancement of Jubilee Field and the planting of trees, bulbs and
 shrubs and generally enhancing outside areas of the village (Greener Staplehurst).
- <u>Balance c/fwd. for future budget</u> The sum of £15,271.74 has been carried forward to settle committed funds for stabilising the planter wall at The Parade, the redecoration of Bell Lane Toilets, skatepark repairs and repaint, footpath signs, Surrenden Field surfacing repairs, Jubilee Field legal fees to update the appointed trustees and a management & maintenance contract, Wimpey Field gate alterations, a donation to the Men's Shed project, updating the Neighbourhood Plan and outstanding auditing fees for 2020-2021.
- <u>Rural Warden Rural Community Alcohol Project</u> The £900 fund is held on behalf of the Rural Warden who aims to reduce anti-social behaviour related to alcohol within our rural community. No movements occurred during the financial year.
- <u>Rural Warden Dementia Cafe</u> The reserve of £400.00 is held on behalf of the Rural Warden to assist local people suffering from dementia.
- <u>Rural Warden Youth Club Project</u> The reserve of £366.44 is held on behalf of the Rural Warden to improve the Youth Club facilities. No movements occurred during the financial year.
- SEHT Covid-19 Fund Grants and donations amounting to £8,440 were received by SEHT to support residents who required help throughout the pandemic. A total of £4,394.38 has been spent to date.

SECTION 137 PAYMENTS - Section 137 of the Local Government Act 1972 enables Parish Councils to spend up to the product of £8.32 per elector for the benefit of people in the area and on activities or projects not specifically authorised by other powers. Electoral Roll stood at 4,976, thereby resulting in a limit of £41,400.32. The Council spent £2,100.00 on donations.

ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY – The Parish Council published three newsletters and the 2019-20 Annual Report of the Parish Council. Apart from one edition of the newsletter that could not be delivered due to Covid-19 restrictions, these were distributed to every household in the parish. The total cost of these was £1,294.00 for printing, plus some additional costs for postage and stationery to outlying areas amounting to £552.50.

PENSIONS - For the year ended 31st March 2021 the Parish Council paid £6,900 into the Local Government Pension Scheme following exit on 28th February 2017. Payment of this annual sum will terminate in 2022. The Employer's contributions for eligible staff into a Workplace Pension Scheme (NEST) were 8% of payroll for 3 members.
