Discussion	<p>There was a long discussion regarding the Local Development Plan and its impact on traffic through the village due to proposed housing developments in Aylesham and Eythorne/Elvington.</p> <p>JSM Consulting had produced a report, a summary of which can be found on the PC website, Local Plan Consultation.</p> <p>www.noningtonpc.co.uk</p> <p>Jonathan Simmons gave a summary of the report and it was decided that the PC should ask DDC for more time for comments to be made before the 17th March deadline. A flyer had been delivered to every house in Nonington and Frogham explain the need to make our views known.</p> <p>It was clear that traffic would become an even more serious issue for Nonington and all residents were asked to send in their views to DDC either via the website. Discussion	A new dashcam had been purchased and will provide good video of nuisance motorbikes now the power supply issue has been sorted. It could be sited anywhere a resident volunteered to house it.		
	Cllr Clayton discussed the use of air quality monitors to measure Nitrogen Dioxide, a major pollutant from traffic. A quote was now being obtained for 12 months of monitors and data analysis.		
	Motorbikes were still an issue and parishioners were urged to telephone the police using the 101 number every time there was an incident otherwise the police would think nothing was amiss. The fence behind the village hall had now been replaced which would hopefully stop motor bikes using the field and footpath.		
	The proposed traffic survey had now been agreed with KCC. This would begin week commencing 26 th April and would have strips at key points around the village roads.

He asked for any names of people killed either in battle or by the bombing raids that happened in Nonington.</p> <p>Several white road markings, manholes, potholes and blocked drains had been reported.</p> <p>The double fence that has appeared on the field opposite Prima was part of a new hedge building project.</p>
