

MALTHOUSE WELL

Despite Storms Ciara and Dennis doing their best in the last month the rain in February has been about average with around 50mm falling, a similar level to January. The Malthouse well reading now stands at around 5.1 metres (approx 17ft) below ground level which is a rise of about 1.7 metres (approx 5ft) during February.

The good news is that this is somewhat lower when compared to the same time in the 2014 flood year when the Malthouse well peaked at a record 2.48 metres (approx 8 ft). Thankfully we are about 2.5 metres lower now compared to then. Roll on Spring...
