Finance Report for year ended 31st March 2022

The Parish Council has received £13,996.00 from Shropshire Council in precept monies to enable it to carry out its statutory functions during the year.

The Parish Council received £17,102.92 in this financial year from the CIL Neighbourhood fund which the Parish Council will spend on community projects.

The Council has spent £ 31,851.22 which is broken down in the year end accounts.

The Council has provided two additional street lights in an area of the Parish which was very dark and this was done for the peace of mind of the residents. It has also made grants to the Village Hall to assist in some much needed improvements to the village community building

The Council has reviewed and where it was deemed necessary updated their general and financial risk assessments documents.

The Council has in all aspect of its financial dealings adhered to strict guidelines ensuring that all decisions represent best value for money for the community and as a result had an unqualified report from the External Auditors for the previous year.

The accounts have been inspected by the Internal Auditor who found nothing to report to the Council.

The Parish Council has appointed a Data Protection Office to comply with the GDPR which came into force on 25th May 2018. It has had its data audit and is well on the way to becoming fully compliant with the new regulations.
