Blind Lane – The owners of Petworth have lodged an appeal against enforcement. The hearing will be on 8<sup>th</sup> August at 10am. It has been noted that a caravan from the property has been removed from the site and placed on Kingsford Street, the Community Warden has reported this to both Ashford Borough Council and the Police.

S.106 agreement for Stour Park (U19) is causing delay to progress of Kingsford Street close off and turning circle construction.

Waterbrook Dev't. GSE is causing contention with the placement of the enlarged lorry park, putting a large lorry park adjacent to houses is ill-advised.

Various sites as part of Ashford Borough Council's 2030 plan have come to light. They are broadly not contentious for this area. 350 extra houses on Finberry, extra 50 houses on Waterbrook, Village Hall site but the Old Rectory Close site is contentious. The public consultation is now open and is on-going until 31<sup>st</sup> August. It is important to be supportive of what you want to see. Note the lorry park should not be too close to the houses.

Planning Infringement Issue at Bower Farm – Cllr Bartlett has objected, the Council will object, the residents have lodged objections. No planning consent has been given and it is hoped that the issue can be easily resolved. Cllr Turley will forward details to the Clerk for the Council to lodge an objection and Cllr Turley will also contact Richard Alderton with regard to the matter.

Kent Wool Growers is not going in to U19 as they are experiencing financial difficulties. Has the land been

sold on? It may have been sold on but Ashford Borough Council are still dealing with Financial Life with regard to this site.

#### **Report from Community Warden**

The Community Warden that it had been quite a quiet month, the caravan at Kingsford Street has a couple residing in it but has been reported.

There was an abandoned vehicle in Chequer Tree Farm Road but this has now been removed.

The school had been involved in the Safety in Action Event.

# Co-option of a replacement Councillor for Mersham Ward

A letter of resignation was received from Cllr Sawdon from the Sevington Ward. Cllr Oakley-Hills proposed that Henrietta Sawdon be co-opted as a Parish Councillor for Mersham Ward. Cllr Murphy seconded this proposal and all were in favour. Henrietta will be co-opted officially at the next meeting.

The Clerk will notify Ashford Borough Council that a vacancy has arisen on the Sevington ward and an advet will be produced.

Cllr Turley had produced a draft response to the Local Plan. Cllrs Turley and Murphy have met with residents and Cllr Bartlett. The draft is written on the basis that it will be discussed and circulated and when finalised the Clerk will submit the document.

- Given the information provided The Parish Council had a low confidence level in whether any of the suggested village benefits would be realised.
- The final view of any revised planning request would need to be considered in light of the outcome of the approved 2030 plans.
- There was concern about the traffic/access impact.
- The extent to which loss of green space within village centre would be assessed once detail plans available.
