Since January 2019 the Parish Council has explored ways in which to achieve a Christmas Tree on Misson Village Green. Navigating through the complex process

to provide an electricity supply for the lights has been difficult and time consuming so it was a great relief when the junction box was eventually installed the week before the big switch-on planned for Saturday November 30th.

The Parish Council are grateful to the individuals and community groups in Misson as well as the County Councillor whose contributions helped to make this such a successful event. It was a very exciting moment when the lights were finally turned on, accompanied by carol singing and the Bessacarr Community Band. There were fine offerings of mulled wine and cider together with seasonal fayre and gifts for the children. The whole event was provided without charge and £116 was raised for community projects through voluntary donations on the evening.

All in all, a very happy hour was spent on the Village Green with a gathering of around 100 people and the feedback received has been very positive. The Parish Council plan to make this an annual event and we hope people enjoy the glow of a tree not only this Christmas but also for many years to come.

Shale Gas Update

Having drilled an exploratory well and collected samples, iGas are still technically within the evaluation phase of the planning consent they were granted for Springs Road. They had said that they would not drill the second (lateral) well unless they were certain of obtaining further planning consent to frack. However, the current government imposed moratorium on shale gas development now means that nothing is likely to happen up at the Springs Road site any time soon.
