The Borough Councillor was asked if there is any news on the Planning Inspector's response regarding Chequer Tree Paddock. There was no response to date.	
To receive an update regarding the creation of a green buffer zone in Highfield and the current situation	
at the Inland Border Facility Cllr Bartlett reported that the DfT are preparing a planning application through Ashford Borough Council for the use of the IBF site post 2025. The Minister has assured the MP that planting will recommence on Highfield in 2023.	
To receive an update on Highways Issues (Including the Highways Improvement Plan) Some of the new road markings are complete but not all, the Clerk has been corresponding with Kent Highways about this.	All
3 Councillors and the Clerk met with 2 members of Kent Highways. Major restructure of Church Road is in the plan but funds have not yet been committed. The Highways Steward and Engineer both understood the issue and may be able to temporarily fill the worst of the pot holes to make the road safer. The drainage issues on Kingsford Street were also discussed and will be referred to drainage to look into.
