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1. Aim

This Plan has been initiated by the Parish Council so that, in the event of an emergency occurring in the parish of Weston, there is a clear understanding of the support available to the emergency services, local authorities and other agencies involved in responding to an incident in the parish and in the event of that response being delayed.

The plan provides a guide as to how and where the local community may support the emergency services in terms of

- Providing a co-ordinated response from the community
- Assisting the emergency services in the identification of an initial place of safety for residents should evacuation be necessary
- Assisting where necessary in identifying the location of vulnerable people
- Identifying hazards and possible mitigation measures
- Identifying resources and key contacts in the community

2. Emergency Community Co-ordinator

A person living locally who provides a vital link between the community and other organisations planning and responding to an emergency. The role is to:

- Provide a link to the District Emergency Planning Officer
- Call a community meeting during an emergency (if deemed necessary)
- Provide the focal point for the community response to an emergency.

- To work with the emergency services and local authorities in response to an emergency affecting the parish
- To communicate regularly with the District/County Council Emergency Planning teams
- To identify vulnerable persons in the parish and assist in ensuring their welfare needs are met during an emergency
- To set up a temporary place of safety (Village Hall) if required and a control facility to coordinate the Parish Council response
- To keep residents within the parish informed of the situation

Cllr. David Chase – Snow Warden and Flood Warden, liaison with farmers






Annex 1- Location - Ladywood Farm (NG23 6TD)
