- Daniel Wilson has confirmed that the allotments will be included in the plans on Finberry once the link road is complete.
- There is to be a meeting in October regarding the Community Centre on Finberry. Cllr Bartlett would like the Parish Council to consider this and will request a steer on this at the next full Parish Council meeting.
- The food check delays referred to in the report from Cllr Bartlett are 3 month delays, checks will commence in January 2024.
- Cllr Bartlett had communicated with Cllr Whybrow regarding the parking issues on Church Road. It is suggested that a "dog bone" white line could be painted on the road opposite the dropped kerb to try and stop people from parking.

It was noted that the contractor on HML is no longer working and so the maintenance of Finberry is not being undertaken. The grass and weeds are quite high now. Following a resolution with the waste issue, it was agreed that the Clerk would contact Tracey Butler thanking ABC for assisting and asking them to liaise with Crest/HML for reassurances that the Finberry environment will be looked after as a whole.
