Driving in Winter (Extract from West Berks Advice leaflet)

West Berks Council salt the primary routes throughout the winter months, from mid – November to the end of March.

Main Street is a primary route, through Farnborough, Main Street, East Ilsley and on into Compton.

West Berks supplies and maintains around 200 roadside salt bins, these are for use by the general public on roads with steep hills which are not on primary salting routes, ie Bury Lane.

Before embarking on a journey in winter check your vehicle.

- Keep your battery fully charged.
- Check tyre treads and pressure.
- Keep antifreeze in radiator and
- Keep low freezing screen wash in washer bottle topped up.
- Keep a can of deicer and a scraper in your vehicle.
- Before you start your journey, clear ice and condensation from windscreen, side windows and mirrors.

Make sure windows, wipers, lights and indicators are clean and in good order.
