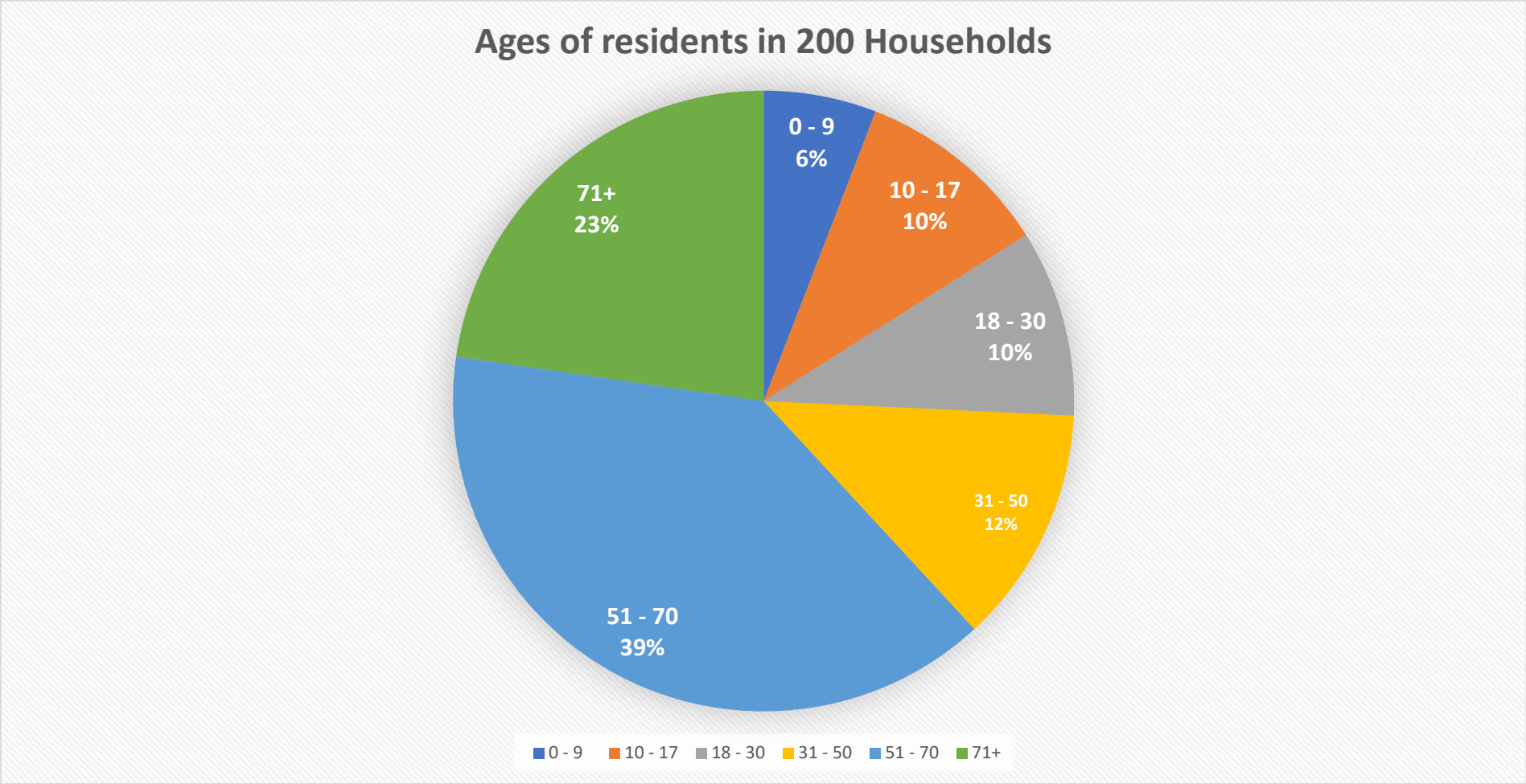
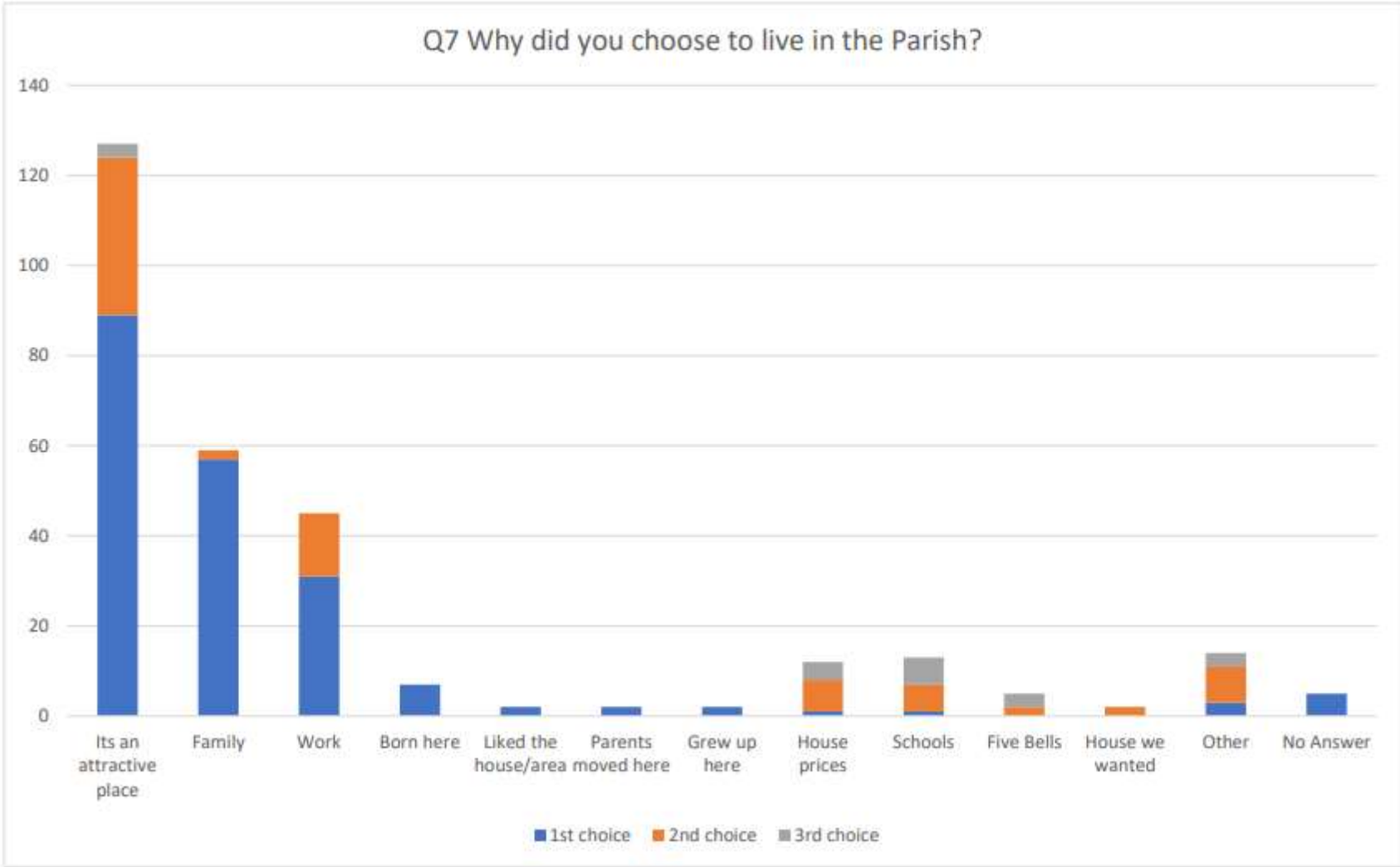

**6. How many people of the following ages are in your household?**

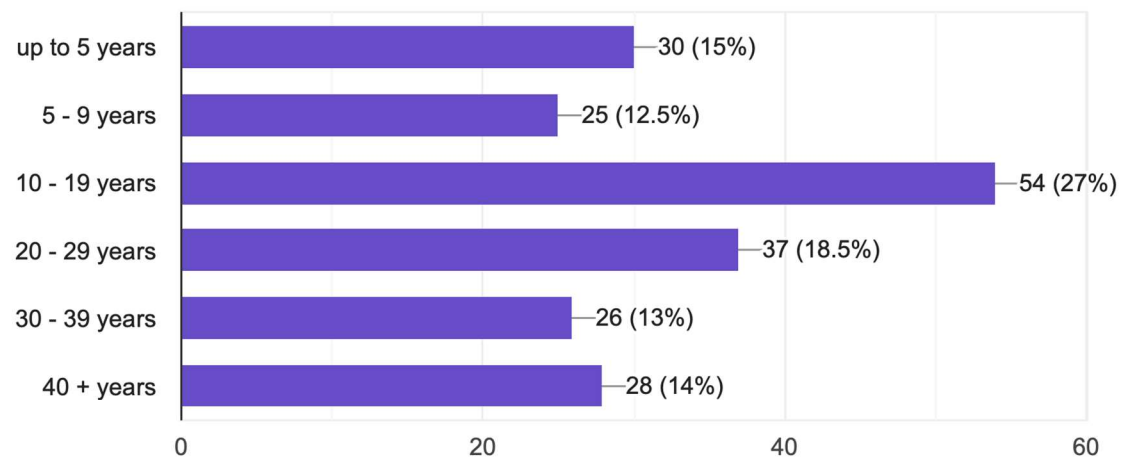

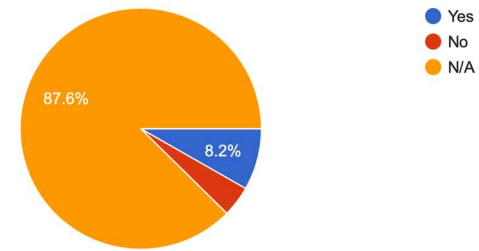
49. If you answered "yes" to Q48, is your business based in the Parish?

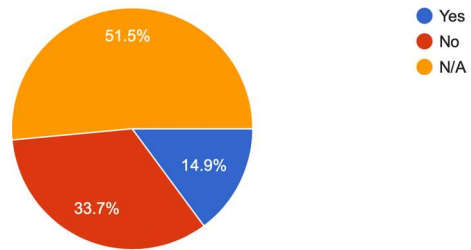
