High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high-speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing.

To carry out piling works for the new Stoneleigh Road overbridge, we will require multi-way temporary traffic lights, and to close a section of Stareton Lane.

When will these works be taking place?

Stoneleigh road will have temporary lights in place from 2 to 5 October 2023, from 8am to 6pm, and 8am to 1pm on 6 October, please refer to Map 1.

Stareton Lane will be closed with a diversion in place from 2 to 5 October 2023, 8am to 6pm, and 8am to 1pm on 6 October please refer to Map 2.

Access to all properties will be maintained. Our workforce maybe on site one hour before and one hour after to set up and secure our equipment.



MAP 1




— Line of Works


