Sutton upon Tern Parish Council is developing partnerships with the local Police. The new Police Officer covering the Parish is PC 1545 Iain McIntosh based in the Safer Neighbourhood Team (SNT) at Market Drayton Police Station.

PC Iain McIntosh attended his first Parish Council meeting in May 2023 and raised the following Police campaigns with the Parish Council.

Smart Water has a unique forensic code that, once applied, makes equipment traceable back to their owner, it is easy to apply and only visible under UV light and each application is guaranteed to last 5 years under normal circumstances.

One of the key aspects to the Smart Water system is the fact that it is recognised by criminals as each person arrested is scanned for traces of Smart Water meaning that they are aware of it and are aware that if they have traces on them they will be arrested and the product matched to the unique batch. Combined with stickers placed in prominent windows on the approach to houses protected by Smart Water and larger signage on roads in and out of protected streets/areas there has been a significant reduction in burglaries in those areas.

Sutton upon Tern Parish Council has **two vacancies** that need to be filled to enable the Parish Council to function properly. Since the May 2021 elections the Parish Council has struggled on some occasions. There are six face to face meetings a year lasting about an hour and a community led housing working group which at present is meeting every couple of months for which the Parish Council is looking to **recruit more volunteers** with an interest in housing. The Parish Council has also developed a rights of way working group to undertake practical tasks on several rights of way and are looking to **recruit more volunteers** to help out on these practical environmental projects.
