## RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE DIFFERENT TIERS OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT

The Parish Clerk receives multiple inquiries each week regarding different issues around the village. Many of these issues are not within the remit of the Parish Council to rectify so the clerk is unable to directly action these and has to refer them on. The process for reporting issues we follow is no different than if a resident of the village was to report it themselves. In terms of getting action taken it is better if a number of people report the same thing rather than just coming from the Parish Council.

We thought it would be helpful for residents to outline what each council (Parish, Borough and County) is responsible for so that residents can directly report issues to the appropriate authority. The table below lists the responsibilities and provides both the web site address and contact telephone number so that residents can make direct contact.

It would be appreciated if you could take note of who is responsible for what problem and make direct contact rather than reporting everything to the Parish Clerk. The Parish Council will be happy to take on issues that we are directly responsible for.
