HAMBLE-LE-RICE (or Hamble) is a parish and fishing village in the Southern division of the county, hundred of Mainsbridge, union of South Stoneham and county court district of Southampton, diocese and archdeaconry of Winchester and rural deanery of Bishop's Waltham,  $5\frac{1}{4}$  miles south-east from Southampton and 2 south from Netley railway station, standing on a point of land at the confluence of the Hamble river and Southampton Water. The village is on the west side of the river Hamble, where there is a ferry to Warsash, a village in the parish of Titchfield.
