Broadband Special

There is the opportunity for Weston to improve the broadband provision by having fibre broadband all the way to your house or business premises. This will not only give the potential to have up to 1Gb speeds but will increase reliability and future proof the village.

Over the last year, we have been working with Openreach to cost this project and get DCMS approval. This has been granted and, in order for it to go ahead, we need people in the village to sign up. For each person that commits, we will get a voucher for £1,500 and for each business £3,500 towards the £140,000 cost. The only commitment you will be asked for is that, once this is installed in the village, you will upgrade your broadband to a speed at least double your current rate.
