Finance

Precept levied for the financial year 2018/2019 was £16,517.00.

Other income during the year was Bank interest of £7.96, plus VAT refund of £602.99

The total income for the year was £17,127.95, which when added to the accumulated balance gave a working total of £48,209.69

During the year total expenditure was £14,318.18 which results in a surplus of £33,891.51

Included in this is £12,791.11 of earmarked funds.
