NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

BRAMLEY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN AREA

Referendum on the adoption of the Neighbourhood Plan for Bramley

1. A referendum will be held on **Thursday 18 November 2021** to decide on the question below:

“Do you want Waverley Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Bramley to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote must be received by the Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 2 November 2021**. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
3. New applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of existing proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, The Burys, Godalming, Surrey, GU7 1HR by **5 pm on Wednesday 3 November 2021**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, The Burys, Godalming, Surrey, GU7 1HR by **5 pm on Wednesday 10 November 2021**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum applied for on grounds of physical incapacity, or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, The Burys, Godalming, Surrey, GU7 1HR by **5 pm on Thursday 18 November 2021**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after **5 pm on Wednesday 10 November 2021**. To apply on grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday 10 November 2021.
