The total to be distributed was  $\pounds 11,291$ .

No applications had been refused to date.

## 4. ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Cllr Riley thanked the Clerk for preparing a report to the donors, which she thought to be very informative.

The committee considered that the winding down of the furlough scheme was likely to increase hardship and it was therefore a good time to remind residents that the fund was available to help those affected by the pandemic. Mr Lawrence will put a post on the Frittenden Community Facebook page and will ask whether a poster could be put on the door of Stable Stores at the Bell & Jorrocks. Cllr Staples will put a notice in the Parish Magazine.
