- All volunteers, coaches and officials will understand and be supported in their role and responsibility with regard to the duty of care for young people and vulnerable adults;
- All suspicions and allegations will be taken seriously, managed and dealt with swiftly and appropriately;
- The club will appoint a Safeguarding Officer whose role is to be responsible for issues concerning safeguarding at the club.
