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





## What were your preferences on housing development?

#### Rate of growth:

- 34% -> UP TO 1 HOUSE / YEAR
- 34% -> BETWEEN 1 AND 2 HOUSES/YEAR

#### **Type of Development**

- 60% -> LOW COST STARTER HOMES
- 53% ->FAMILY HOMES
- **35% ->** SMALLER 2-3 BED HOUSES
- 17% ->1-2 BED AND 3-4 BED HOUSES
- 88% -> VISUAL FIT WITH SURROUNDING HOUSES







DoE - Floodplain habitat classification: Grazing Marsh (blue) and an Environmentally Sensitive Area (Pink)








#### **Local Green Spaces must:**
