


Woore: Temporary highway modifications and additional safety measures

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. The A51 and A525 have been designated as construction traffic routes by HS2. The map and key below provide an overview and the indicative locations of temporary highway modifications and proposed supplementary traffic calming and safety measures in Woore Parish.



Highway modifications

Highway modifications are being undertaken across Phase 2a to enhance the local road network and ensure it can support HS2 construction traffic

1 Temporary modifications to junction of A525 and A51.

2-8 Temporary modifications including 9 passing bays and 3 areas of localised widening across 7 locations on the A525.



Supplementary traffic calming and road safety measures

All proposed additional measures will be delivered ahead of HS2 main construction work, subject to passing a Road Safety Audit and the necessary approvals from the local highways authority.

- 1 A51 speed gateway upgrade including features such as anti-skid red coloured surfaces, additional dragons teeth markings, speed limit roundels, no overtaking signs and speed limit signage.
- 2 Access only sign for Bearstone Road.
- 3 Convex mirrors for all exits at Pipe Gate onto A51.
- 4 Signage for HS2 HGV traffic to avoid slip road in Pipe Gate alongside A51.
- 5 New uncontrolled pedestrian crossing at Pipe Gate.
- 6 Access only sign for Gravenhunger Lane.
- 7 Additional measures to enhance crossing on A525 near school bus drop off such as a potential new crossing or further signage.
- 8 A525 speed gateway upgrade including features such as anti-skid red coloured surfaces, additional dragons teeth markings, speed limit roundels, no overtaking signs and speed limit signage.
- 9 Access only sign for Gravenhunger Lane.
- 10 Access only sign for Cherry Tree Lane.
- 11 Access only sign for Candle Lane.
- 12 A51 speed gateway upgrade including features such as anti-skid red coloured surfaces, additional dragons teeth markings, speed limit roundels, no overtaking signs and speed limit signage.
- 13 Removal and cutting back of hedge at highway boundary (near Falcon Inn) to improve footway provision.
- 14 Upgrade of existing uncontrolled crossing point to zebra and relocation away from modified junction.
- 15 Upgrade to crossing outside school and enhancement of existing signage with school roundel markings and Crossing Patrol Officer (in agreement with council) during school drop off and pick up.
- 16 Five Vehicle Activated Signs along A51 in Woore, with two of these being larger and showing more information.
- 17 Anti-skid coloured surfacing and "Slow" text road marking on the A51 southbound approach to the A51/A525 junction.
