| Advisory Committees ${ }^{5}$ | - Non-councillors can be members <br> - Sub-Committees can meet in private. <br> - Full Council can receive detailed advice, speeding up decision making. <br> - All Councillors feel involved in the decision taken. | - Decisions can't be made, only suggestions given to Full Council or Committee. <br> - Subject to election year requirements as above. <br> - Meetings must be public and subject to notices, agendas and minutes. (Where not a SubCommittee) <br> - Must be Quorate as per SO. |
| Working Groups | - Not subject to public meetings, notices, agendas, or minutes. <br> - Council or parent committee establish TOR. <br> - MOP can be members. <br> - All advice is reported to Council or Committee. <br> - Officers are not required to attend. <br> - Wine can be involved. | - No decision-making powers. <br> - Proper Officer can follow the advice and make a decision. <br> - No TOR are required. <br> - Not subject to Quorum requirements. |
