09/20 Correspondence/AOB

- a) Revised Habitat Mitigation Scheme SPD: six-week public consultation (8 January to midday 19 February 2020): The Councillors agreed that any response will be made individually; not by the PC.
- b) NFDC Boundary Review Consultation:
- Latest figs no. of NFDC councillors will be reduced from 60 to 49 effective from 2023 elections.
- Bramshaw will be grouped with Copythorne (joined North and South), Netley Marsh, and Ashurst & Colbury. The Parish Council accept this grouping and do not wish to submit a comment to the review.
- A discussion took place as the what constitutes the boundary of Bramshaw, in particular the very small cluster of households (the north side of the M27) which come within the Minstead PC boundary. These residents are often known to contact Bramshaw councillors in the belief they're part of Bramshaw PC. This appears to be down to their geographical proximity, and the man-made physical (and dominant) M27 boundary separating them from Minstead PC. As a result, MC to write to Minstead PC inviting their thoughts on these households moving within the Bramshaw PC boundary.
