

# BSJ Community Speedwatch Update

## May 2021

- Two methods of controlling speed in the village:
  - Speed Indicator Device (SID) located at the north end of the village
  - Community Speedwatch
- The CSW team is key in identifying and recording speeding vehicles and their registrations and advising the police who follow up with letters and visits if required
- 12 volunteers, sessions every 2 weeks (share the device with Middle Woodford), most volunteers do two x 1hr sessions over the two week period)
- Sessions stopped in Mar 20 (first lockdown), resumed in Jul 20, but then stopped again in Dec 20 and resumed 29<sup>th</sup> Mar 2021
- Two roles – Speed Device Operator (recording vehicle speeds) and Data Logger (recording vehicle registration number, vehicle colour and type and time)
- Training done on site




# CSW Lockdown Stats Mar 20 – Apr 21

The Speed Indicator Device (SID) at the northern end of the village continues to help bring the speed down for traffic entering the village – 86% of vehicles are doing less than 36mph.

However:

- Total incoming vehicles 91,258 of which 12,840 (c.14%) speeding
- Total outgoing vehicles 74,779 of which 15,910 (c.21%) speeding
- Highest recorded speed 79mph leaving the village
- Highest recorded speed 73mph coming into the village



## CSW Sessions:

- 44 watches between Mar 20 – Apr 21 (48 hrs)
- Apr – Dec 19: 70 watches, 3046 vehicles, 152 speeders
- One of the highest % of speeding vehicles in South Wiltshire - 4.99% compared with Middle Woodford 2.39%
