## Chairmans report

We are in a unique position with money to spend, from the CIL money and various rebates form NSDC over the last couple of years

We have been again able to hold the precept at $50 \%$ of previous years
There have been improvements to the Village Hall - new heating, sound baffling, replacement chairs

Lettings have been increasing, including a long term let
We have received some CIL money from Shaws development - requested and agreed to put towards installing water on the allotments. We do need to advertise vacant plots

Donation to Halam C of E School for an outside classroom
Paid for 2 marquees for Halam Events
Queens Jubilee - bought mugs for each household and had a bonfire - was a successful evening

Organised 4 new gateway signs 2 are up and 2 to be put up later this year

Planning - out of all applications NSDC agreed with all bar one - Barn Cottage and the Dials is still pending, though they have agreed so far
