Meeting held on 14 September 2023 at 19:30.

- 2 Declarations of Interest. None declared.

Having considered the Minutes of the meeting held on 13 July 2023 Cllrs resolved to approve and sign, as a correct record, which the Chairman then signed as a true record.

The Clerk reported that he had checked with Wilts Council who would not supply signs but would not object to the Council replacing the existing sign and for there to be signs at both ends of the village. - Wiltshire Council Report. Wilts Cllr C Williams reported that the last Tidworth Area Board (TAB) meeting was good and that the high level Police representatives had delivered a well-received presentation. Moreover, The Woodlands Officer had spoken on the drive to plant more trees and that funding was available for this and of the need for tree warden volunteers. £14K grant funding remains available for youth and wellbeing projects. A Webinar on the next Local Plan via TEAMs is scheduled for 10 Oct with walk in presentation to be held in Tidworth Leisure Centre 3.00pm-7.00pm on Wed 18 Oct. Wilts Council budget is showing an overspend of £0.3 million which equates to 0.10 of the overall budget. Wilts Council was actively pursuing the removal of the travellers at the old Everleigh Recycling Centre. Planning permission has been submitted for 18 affordable houses on the Bartlett Hose site in

Ludgershall. The Hampshire Council AV5 Bus services were replaced on 11 September by the CV 5 Taxi Bus services which will service the Chutes on Wednesdays.

The Clerk suggested that as the My Wilts App doesn't allow you to request/enquire about a more substantive fix the best way forward would be to submit a Highways Improvement Request Form (HIRF) to the Local Highways & Footpaths Improvement Group (LHFIG) for consideration at the group's next meeting which is scheduled for 5.30pm on 11 October at the Tidworth Leisure Centre. Moreover, the request should be followed up by the Council at the next Tidworth Area Board Meeting (TAB) which is scheduled for 7.00pm on 6 November in the Ludgershall Memorial Hall. After discussion Clirs RESOLVED that the Chairman was to submit a HIRF to the LHFIG by Monday 1 October and that he was to attend the LHGIG meeting at 5.30 on Wednesday 11 October in the TLC Conference Room to present the case and that Cllr Farrel was to attend the TAB meeting at 7.00pm on Monday 6 November in the Memorial Hall Ludgershall to press the case as required.
