2. Items from members of the Public

Shropshire Councillor Mr D Evans attended the meeting and reported on Shropshire Council issues. Mr M White raised concerns about the speeding of vehicles through Bushmoor and enquired if a 30mph speed limit could be considered. Cllr D Evans reported that currently no new road safety issues were being considered until 2020 however he would take up the concerns with the relevant section of Shropshire Council and enquire about the implementation of advisory speed limits. The Clerk had placed an order for the provision and installation of the new equipment which had been approved by the Village Hall Committee.
