National and County Competition News

Bowls England. The national competition draws have been done and can be found on their website www.bowlsengland.com The national finals at Leamington will run from Thursday 10th to Sunday 27th August. See the Competitions Portal section of the website for all the details.

Bowls Leicestershire. The competition draws are on the website www.bowlsleicestershire.com Leicestershire will have two Leamington qualifiers in all women's and men's Championship events, except for Senior Fours and Junior Pairs where there will be one qualifier.

Parks Matches and Competitions

Several Leicester City & District Parks Association matches have been arranged this season which any member can play in. An email was sent out in February with a list of fixtures which are all on Sundays. Please speak to Roger Bartlett if you would like the list sending to you again. Please note that six matches clash with our own mixed fixtures.

The Parks competition draws involving our members are displayed in the men's changing room. Semi-finals take place w/c 17th July with finals the week after, both at South Wigston. Loughborough Triples League: Our two teams are in Division 1 and matches start on Monday 24th April with reigning champions Sands away to Shepshed and Lighthouse at home to Brush. The first game between the two Birstall teams takes place on Monday 12th June.

Leicester League: We are in Division 1 with the first match on Wednesday 3rd May at home to Countesthorpe. The first round of the cup is on Wednesday 24th May against Knighton with two rinks home and two away.

Ladies Friday Triples League: We have three teams entered with the first matches being played on Friday 23rd June. 14 teams in total will take part in the competition. £100 was donated to charity from the proceeds of last season.

Potters 2024

Marlene and Roger Bartlett have arranged a trip to Potters in March 2024. An email was sent on 8th March with the details. The cost, if a minimum group booking of 21 is reached, is £459 per person based on a standard bungalow (with supplements if you wish to upgrade to bungalow plus or the hotel). This includes all meals and drinks (with the odd exception) during your stay, a minimum of four bowls matches, sports, leisure activities and live entertainment each night. The above price is based on self-drive as the quote for return coach travel is £1500. A £50 deposit per person is required by 10th April to secure your place.
