

To consider the request for a food van to be parked in the Parish once a week in the evenings:

We're fully COVID compliant - all outdoors, staggered click 'n' collect preorders on the online system so no queueing or gathering as such. Walk-up's are okay too but off-peak is preferred and card payments online please. We are in Winchester every Saturday and have been going down really well in nearby villages for the last few months.

In my experience it's a really positive thing for the villagers! Simple joys, a night off the stove and something people can experience and share in these times.

Logistically we normally would do

- Trading 4-8pm (with an hour either side for set up/pack down)
- No bins/power/anything else required - we leave no trace and are self sufficient. Just space to park really!
- 5* food hygiene rating and all relevant health and safety, risk assessments etc attached
- We take click n collect pre-orders online through our website, but also do accept some walk-up's
- We limit the pre-orders and walk-up's are okay but peak time (6:30-7:30) is best avoided and card payments only please!
- So far on precedent we normally donate £40 to the hall for use of the space for the time

In a non-lockdown world I find a monthly visit keeps it fresh and 'special' let's say, although there is certainly increased demand for a break from the stove.
